

ROCK SALT THE ECONOMICAL & EFFECTIVE WAY TO MELT ICE & SNOW

DESCRIPTION:

Sprinkle evenly on sidewalks, driveways, steps, porches and any other walkway to easily melt ice and snow. Use generously under wheels when an auto is trapped on ice or stuck in snow. ROCK SALT should assist automobile tires to gain traction. For best results use 1/2 cup per square yard. ROCK SALT is not recommended on brick or flagstone walkways containing mortar joints or masonry. Do not use on concrete less than one year old.

DID YOU KNOW?

ROCK SALT may cause concrete surfaces to deteriorate faster and may be harmful to vegetation, including flower beds, shrubs, trees, or grass. For the best results, be sure to use only the recommended amount of rock salt and remove slush regularly. The potential for concrete damage should always be weighed against the potential for injury from slipping on ice.
